1. Apologies for absence if any. Apologies from Cllr Mark Charles, accepted. No apologies from Cllr. Green
2. Declarations of Interest and requests for dispensations if any. CIIr Jackson declared an interest in agenda item 13-1 $1^{\text {st }}$ Planning app on list.
3. To approve and sign minutes of Parish Council meeting held on $17^{\text {th }}$ January 2022. Resolved to approve as a true record.
4. Public Participation - The Council meeting will be adjourned at this point for a period not exceeding 15 minutes to allow members of the public to ask questions on items on the agenda.
5. Parish Councillors Reports on meetings they have attended as Parish Council representatives. Cllr Sharp attended Councillor Training with LRALC. Cllr Cole has viewed the slides on Community Engagement following a LCC workshop.
6. Borough and County Councillor's Reports. No Borough or County Councillors present. Clerk to request they submit their reports prior to the meeting if unable to attend.
7. Clerks Report - Broadnook Inception meeting cancelled on Friday $18^{\text {th }}$ February due to storm Eunice, has been rescheduled for Tues $22^{\text {nd }}$ February. Clerk has had very positive feedback from residents regarding the restoration that has began on Mill Race/Sheepwash bridge on Brooky Lane.
8. Parish Film Night - To receive report of Parish Film "Nomadland" shown on $11^{\text {th }}$ February 2022. 38 people attended the film Nomadland and a profit of $£ 125.79$ was made.
9. To receive and consider letter from local Gardening Club. Clerk to contact Gardening Club and suggest they make contact with local businesses to see if they are willing to give some financial help. Parish Council awarded the Gardening Club grant of $£ 250$ for 2022/2023
